- Compost is available at the Wastewater Treatment Plant for Village residents free of charge. Please call 315-673-4491 to make an appointment for pickup.
- The 6th grade class from Driver Middle School volunteered their time sprucing up Fred's Trail, the Town Hall's garden beds, Marcellus Park and the Historical Society inside and out. We are thankful for their community service and appreciate their efforts to keep our community tidy!
- Olde Home Days Celebration – as mentioned before, will be June 5-7 and we encourage residents to attend.

- American flags will be hung on Main Street, South Street, and North Street in preparation for the Memorial Day Parade.
- The Village and Town DPW are working with Marcellus First Responders Committee with their Hometown Hero banner program.
- Annual Arbor Day celebration will be held May 22nd at 10am at the Green Gateway! All are welcome to attend
- This spring has been especially wet, with over 6 inches of rain in March alone and more than 16 inches year-to-date. As a result, flows into the treatment plant are above average. As a reminder to residents and property owners, please ensure that sump pumps, roof downspouts, exterior foundation drains, and areaway drains are not connected—directly or indirectly—to the Village sanitary system.
