

Section 1. Chapter 106, Article IV, of the Code of the Village of Marcellus is hereby amended to add § 106-33 as follows:

Section 106-33 – The Board of Trustees may establish a fee, which may be modified from time to time by resolution, to be paid the Village in the event any unpaid fees or charges for municipal or municipally contracted solid waste collection and/or disposal services, including penalties and interest, are re-levied back to Onondaga County.

Section 2. Chapter 198, Article IV, of the Code of the Village of Marcellus is hereby amended to add §§ 198-81 - 198-83 as follows:

Section 198-81 – All unpaid fees or charges for municipal or municipally contracted sewage collection, treatment, and/or disposal, including penalties or interest, not paid by May 1st of each year may be added to the annual Village tax levy.

Section 198-82 - The Board of Trustees shall annually cause a statement to be prepared setting forth each amount of sewage collection, treatment and/or disposal fees in arrears as of thirty days prior to the last date prescribed by law for the annexation of the warrant to the assessment roll, a brief description of the property for which or in connection with which such solid waste services we're provided, and the name and address of the person or corporation liable to pay such amount. Such state shall be presented to the Board of Trustees, which shall levy such amounts remaining unpaid on the date taxes are levied against the real property for which or in connection with which such solid waste services were provided.

Section 198-83 – The Board of Trustees may establish a fee, which may be modified from time to time by resolution, to be paid the Village in the event any unpaid fees or charges for municipal or municipally contracted sewage collection, treatment, and/or disposal, including penalties or interest, are re-levied back to Onondaga County.

Section 3. This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State, and the Village Clerk is directed to immediately file a copy of this Section with the New York State Secretary of State as required by law.
