Mayor Clark explained that the purpose of the public hearing was to allow all interested parties the opportunity to be heard regarding Local Law #1 of 2026, which would amend Chapters 106 and 198 of the Code of the Village of Marcellus to establish re-levy fees and procedures, which may be modified from time to time by resolution, to be paid the Village in the event any unpaid fees or charges for municipal or municipally contracted sewage collection, treatment, and/or disposal, including penalties or interest, are re-levied back to Onondaga County.
